Opaopa ae oe i ka wana a oka-  
oka, alaila, lawe aku oe a waiho

Ma kahi o ka waha e hamama ana,  
waiho aku; alaila, nee mai oe a  
kaawale iki, e ike maopopo aku  
ana no oe i ka upena, a ina no hē  
nui pohaku a onu ake'ake'a naha

ku oe malaila; no ka mea, aole hohonu ke kai; he anana no, a emi mai. Ke ku la no oe nana, a ike no oe i ka i'a i ke komo e ai i ka wana au i opaopa ai, alaila, luu aku la oe.

Ea, hoohanaia mai keia ano upena a ka poe kahiko! Ua nalowale loa keia upéna a ka poe kahiko, aole hoohanaia, no ka ike ole o ka poc hou o keia au.
