NA WAHI PANA O EWA
I HOONALOWALEIA I KEIA
WA A HIKI OLE KE I KEIA

(*Hoomana*)

Eia ka mea nui o ne i mau kalo kaulana nei, ke nalo hia ake nei, o ka mea kakan nei, he mea i noho a kōmamina i keia aina. O keia mau kalo ekolu, na kauia eia; na ai ia, a no i keia hora, na nalo hia mai a'u aku elua kalo, a koe wale ihe no ke kalo hope hookahi e alu nei ia'n.

Eia paha ia A. Kanhi, a i ole ia Lu K. Halualani a me Lu Keonekapu. O keia peco ae la maluna sia paha ia lakou keia mau kalo, a i na aole, alaila, hookahi no kalo-ka-i a makou e mahema nei--minamina wale.

Eia ka moolelo i loaa ai keia wahi Pana o "Keonekailimahula o Ewa." He man ali'i ka mea i loaa ai ka inoa o keia wahi, aole nne i loaa ka laua mau inoa, o ka laua hanu oia ka i mahelo iki ia'u a penei kahi moolelo pokole:

O ke kaikuaana oia ke atii o Oahu nei e noho ana ia ma Waikiki, a o kona kaikaina e noho ana ia ma Waikiki? A no ka pono ole o ka manao o ke kaikaina me ka manao kipi o kona kaikuaana, oia kona hanu; oiai ne'ihi oia au Kahiko he pni lawaiā manō Nihii a pepehi-kanaka oia ia i mea kupālu mano, ai ka loan

ana o keia i'o, ua hantia ma ke alekai a kana kahuna --ua hooko ia, i ka loaa ana o kela i'a nui, ua mabeleia ka mano mai ke poo a ka hi'u--lawe ia na moa a pau oloko a koe ka alualu, hania hoi oloko he lele a paa--hunuia ka alualu i oki ia ai a paa--me ke koe no o na nihonoi o 'ka mano --banian a pau a malikai i wahi e noho ai o ke ali'i. E waho hoi kakou iais e liliu ana no ka hana e hanaaku ai i kona kai-kuaana, oiai oia e noho nanea pu wale ana no.

Oiai ke ali'i e noho ana i Waikiki me ka nanea, a o ke kahuna hoi, oia ka nira i jike. I lekahii la hali aku ke kahunai ke ali'i. "E ke Ali'i. He i'a ko kaikaina, e manao ana e hele mat e noi ia oe e hoihoi-mat i ka i'u ana i Waikiki nei nau e malama, he hiki mai koe o ka elele a ke ali'i imua on, a i biki mai ka elele a ke ali'i--a i kamailio mai i ka makemake o ko kaikaina, hoole aku oe. Eia ka pane a ke ali'i, "heaha hoi ka moa e hoole aku ai i ka makemake o ko'n pokii," i mai ke kahuna--miske oe he i'a kanaka kela, e hele mai ana e kipi ia oe a ililo ae ke aupuni ia iala. Aole palu ia a hau ina mai ana ia'u, ae--nou e ke ali'i ka make maininoe o wan he ali'i ko kahuna, nolu i hahu oiai pale mahoepi oiai no ana a ke kahuno i ke ali'i, biki mai la ka elele mai Waikiki noai.

I ka elele i hiki nui ai me kapa inuit odedo polo etiko nie ka makemake o ke ali'i, a o ka hope ioa inae aku la me ali'i ala, a hoi sku la ia a ba'i inamea a pau

ia 'pono-aia-iua-Ku-kakou e iele ai a niki io ia wa, ua hookakankau na ukana. O ka ukana pohaku-ua ope ia paa i ka lau-aki, ua pafia a paa he makana ia na ke ali'i e noho nei i Waikiki, hania ka manele a pau i wahi e kau ai ka i'a, nlaiku atu-mo, aia nae ke ali'i hoko kahi i noho ai, hele mai ko Waikiki

me ko Moanalua Halawa a hiki i
Walawa. Hookahi no ukana e
lawe nei he pohaku na hoope ia
a pau, auwmo Waipio-hele sku
nei ua i'a nei a ua kula nei.

Oiai ua alii hookuli nei e noho
ana me ke kali o ka hoea aku o
ka i'a a ke kaikaina, ua makau-
kau na mea ai o ka hale. Oiai
oia e noho nanea ana me ka ma-
nuao ole ae he make keia, a oiai
ke kahuna i ike mai ai i ke kao-o
huakai a ke alii o Waikiki iluna
o Waipahu, o koiala mio iho la
noia holo a nalo wale.

Oiai ke kahuna i pulalahio
aku la, a aia hoi ua i'a nei e ku
ana ma kekahi aoao. Ia wa i
heonohonoho mai ai ka luna ka-
na; palua-pakahī na pa'i ai, oia
hoi pohaku-kou ns lima-mamua
ka i'a. Kui paha na lima, o'na
lima o kekahi me kahi—ku-i no
ka huakai me ka hoeho ana o na
leo: "E Ewa e—E kui na lima e
—E Ewa e—e kui na lima e."

Oiai ka hapa nui o na kanaka
e hookanikani piba ana, aia ka
i'a ma kela aoao, ma kahi a ka
i'a e hele ai malaila ka huakai.
Ua poai ia na halau o ke alii
elima-ua poai keia mau halau a
pae, a ua hiki aku hoi ka puni
o na hale i ke 50, aole nae i pau
na kanaka. Oiai keia mau puni
he kaualima, ua ike iho la ua
alii nei na biki; oia no kona wai
puka moi ai mailoko mai o na
i'a nei a ku ana iwaho, a kena no
la e luku iho i na pohaku a pau
loa i ka make, a lilo ka noho alii
i ke kaikaina.

A no keia kui lina ana o na
kanaka me ka lokahi. Oia ka
mea i kapa ponoia a; ke kula
maluna mai o Waipahu, ma kela
aoao makai o ke alanni aupuni
Kahiko, o "Keoneknilimalaula
o Ewa." I mea e ike ai na poc
kamahele kaapuni honua o na
One-knillimalaula uei, oia no ke
kula i kunkulnia iho la i ka hale
wiliko Oahu maluna mai o Wai-
pahu. Aia no i Waipahu ia wahi
Pana, Kapukana wai o Kahuku,
a ma ia puka i hoea mai ai ke
lau kana mai Malihini mai a

kua kapa mai kahuku mai, a loaa ai i kekahī wahine o Waikele, a mai Kahukū ka wahine nana ke kua o ka imi ana mai a loaa ianei.

A penei kahi moolelo o ka buli ana mai a na wahine nei a loaa ianei, mai Kahukū mai e ma na Koolau, hiki mā Kaneohe moe malaila, aole he loaa hoailona iaia ma na Koolau, no ka mea, o kōni hoailona he leo o kona kua, he like ole ke kani ana o na kua apan ana e hele nei e hoolohe pono i ka leo o kana kua. Penei i ka wa e kn-kua ai na kua nei, e loaa no kona leo ka leo—ko na kua apan he kani, he wi, he koele, a hele aku la he loa a moe i Wailupe, aole no he loaa a lohe ia o ke kani o na kua apan, aole hoi i kaua a ao wale ia po, a moe wale no ma Kapalama, aole no he lohe ia a hiki wale ana keia i Waipahu, ku keia hoolohe i ke kauai mai o na kua kuku-kapa, iaia e hoolohe ana me ke aheahē malie o kamakani manunene o Lihue, na ia makani i lawe mai i ka leo o ka ianei kua mai uka mai o ke awawa, no ka mea, na pa iho la kamakani mauka a lawe mai la i ka leo o ka ianei kua.

O kahi a ka wahine e noho nei nana e kuku nei, ma iuka o Keanaapeo. I ka lohe pono ana o ka wahine huli kua, ua pii aku la in ma kahawai, a hiki i kahi ana i lohe ai a loaa pono iho la iaia kana mea i huli mai ni. He lua la ho'i no Kahukū ma-Wainuku me kana ukana no nna i huli mai ai no ka hoamanawani, oia hoi kana kua kuku-kapa, oia kahi moolelo iki nou.
