### NA WAHI PANA O EWA I HOONALOWALEIA I KEIA WA A HIKI OLE KE I KEIA

*(Hoomaniā)*

Eia ka mea nui o na mau kalo kaulana nei, ke nalohia aku nei, o ka mea kakan nei, he mea i noho a kōmanina i keia aina. O keia mau kalo ekolu, na kaulana eia: na ai ia, a no i keia hōna, na nalohia mai a'u aku eua kalo, a koe wale iho no ke kalo hope hookahi e ala nei ia'u.

Eia paha ia A. Kanhi, a i ole ia L. K. Halualani a me L. Keonekapa. O keia pōo ae la maluna aia paha ia lakou keia mau kalo, a i na aole, alaila, hookahi no kalo-ka-i a makou e malama nei--minamina wale.

5--Na wahi Pana mai ka wa Kahiko nui--na hunaia a nalowale, oia ka keia maka peni e hoike aku nei.

Eia ka moolelo i loaia keia wahi Pana o "Keonekailimahaia o Ewa." He mau alii ka mea i loaia ka inoa o keia wahi, aole nō i loaia ka lāna mau inoa, o ka lāna hana oia ka i mahalo iki ia'u a penei kahi moolelo pokole:

O ke kākuaana oia ke alii o Oahu nei e noho ana ia ma Waialeale, a o kona kākuaana e noho ana ia ma Waikiki? A no ka pono ole o ka manao o ke kākuaana me ka manao kipi o kona kākuaana, oia kana hana: oia nō iia oia au Kahiko he pua lawaia manō Ninhi a pepeli-kauaka oia au i mea kupālu manō, ai ka loaia

ana o keia i'a, ua hanaia ma ke  
alakai a kama kahuna—ua hooke  
ia, i ka loaa ana o kela i'a nui,  
ua mabeleia ka mano mai ke poo  
a ka hi'u—lawe ia na mea a pau  
oloko a koe ka alualu, hanaia hoi  
oloko he hale a pau—hunaia ka  
alualu i oki ia ai a pau—me ke  
koe no o na niho oi o ka mano  
—hanaia a pau a maikai i wahi e  
noho ai o ke alii. E waha hoi  
kakaou iaia e liuliu ana no ka  
hana e hana aku ai i koma kai-  
kuana, oia oia a noho nanea  
pu wale ana no.

Oiai ke alii e noho ana i Wai-  
kele me ka nanea, a o ke kahuna  
hoi, oia ka mea i ike. I kekahi  
la hani aku ke kahuna ke alii.  
“E ke Alii. He i'a ko kaikuana,  
e maha ana e hele mai e noi ia  
oe e hoihoi mai i ka i'a ana i  
Waikale nei mau e malama, he  
hiki mai koe o ka elele a ke alii  
imua ou, a i hiki mai ka elele a  
ke alii—a i kamailio mai i ka  
makemake o ko kaikuana, hoole  
aku oe. Eia ka pane a ke alii,  
“heaha hoi ka mea e hoole aku  
ai i ka makemake o ko'u pookii.”  
i mai ke kahuna—make oe he i'a  
kunaka kela, e hele mai ana e  
kipi ia oe a ilio ae ke aupuni ia  
iala. Aole pane ia e hana ina  
mai ana ia'u, ae—nou e ke alii  
ka make mainoia o wai he ala  
iki ke kahuna, aole i hana eia  
pule a hoi oia no ana a ke  
kahuna i ke alii, hiki mai ia ka  
elele mai Waikiki mai.

I ka olele i hiki mai ai me  
kana mau olele polo elike me ka  
makemake o ke alii, a o ka hoi e  
lou na ae aku ia ma alii ala, a  
hoi aku ia ia hani i'ana a pau

ua pono aia ina—Ku-kakaou o  
olele ai a niki ia wa, ua hoo-  
aakaukaou na ukama. O ka ukama  
na pohaku—ua ope ia pau i ka  
lau-aki, ua paia a pau he maka-  
na ia na ke alii e noho nei i Wai-  
kele, hanaia ka manole a pau i  
wahi e kau ai ka i'a, alaila aua-  
mo, aia nae ke ali iloko kahi i  
noho ai, hele mai ke Waikiki  
Hanaia Kamaia Kahi a

me ke Monnalua Halawa a hiki i  
Waiawa- Hookahi no ukama e  
lawe nei he pohaku na hoopa ia  
a paa, auamo-Waipio-hele aku  
nei ua ia nei a ua kula nei.

Oiai ua alii hookahi nei e noho  
ana me ke kahi o ka hooa aku o  
ka ia a ke kaikaina, ua makau-  
kan na mea ai o ka hale. Oiai  
oia e noho nanea ana me ka ma-  
nao ole ae he make keia, a oiai  
ke kahuna i ike mai ai i ke kao-o  
huakai a ke alii o Waikiki ulua  
o Waipahu, o koiaha nio iho la  
noia holo a malowale.

Oiai ke kahuna i pulalahio  
aku la, a nia hoi ua ia nei a ku  
ana ma kekahi aoao. Ia wa i  
hoonohonoho mai ai ka luna ka-  
na; palua-pakahi na pa'i ai, oia  
hoi pohaku-lou na lima-mamua  
ka ia. Kui paha na lima, o na  
lima o kekahi me kahi—ka-i no  
ka huakai me ka hooho ana o na  
leo: "E Ewa e—E kui na lima e  
—E Ewa e—e kui na lima e."

Oiai ka hapa nui o na kanaka  
e hookanikani paha ana, aia ka  
ia ma kela aoao, ma kahi a ka  
ia e hele ai malaila ka huakai.  
Ua poai ia na halau o ke alii  
elima—ua poai keia mau halau a  
pau, a ua hiki aku hoi ka puni  
o na hale i ke 50, aole nae i pau  
na kanaka. Oiai keia mau puni  
he kaaulima, ua ike iho la ua  
alii nei ua hiki; oia no kona wai  
puka mai ai mailoko mai o na  
ia nei a ku ana iwaho, a kena na  
la e luku iho i na pohaku a pau  
loa i ka make, a lilo ka noho alii  
i ke kaikaina.

A no keia kui lima ana o na  
kanaka me ka lokahi. Oia ka  
mea i kapa ponoia ai ke kula  
malua mai o Waipahu, ma kela  
aoao makai o ke alanni aupuni  
Kahiko, o "Keonekuilimalaula  
o Ewa." I mea e ike ai na poc  
kamahete kaapuni houua o ua  
One-kuilimalaula uei, oia no ke  
kula i kukuluia iho la i ka hale  
wiliko Oahu malua mai o Wai-  
pahu. Aia no i Waipahu ia wahi  
Pana, Kapukana wai o Kahuku,  
a ma ia puka i hooa mai ai ke

kua kapa ma i kuku nei, a  
loa ai i kekahi wahine o Wai-  
kele, a mai Kahuku ka wahine  
nana ke kua o ka imi ana mai a  
loa ianei.

A penei kahi moolelo o ka huli  
ana mai a na wahine nei a loa  
iane, mai Kahuku mai e ma na  
Koolau, hiki ma Kaneohe moe  
malaila, aole he loa hoailona  
iaia ma na Koolau, no ka mea, o  
koma hoailona he leo o kona kua.  
he like ole ke kani ana o na kua  
apau ana e hele nei o hoolohe  
pono i ka leo o kana kua. Penei  
i ka wa e ku-kua ai na kua nei,  
e loa no kona leo ka leo—ko na  
kua apau he kani, he wi, he koe-  
le, a hele aku la he loa a moe i  
Wailupe, aole no he loa a lohe  
ia o ke kani o na kua apau, aole  
hoi i kana a no wale ia po, a moe  
wale no ma Kapalama, aole no  
he lolo ia a hiki wale ana keia i  
Waipahu, ku keia hoolohe i ke  
kani mai o na kua kuku-kapa,  
iaia e hoolohe ana me ke aheahe  
malie o kamakani mauunene o  
Lihue, na ia makani i lawe mai i  
ka leo o ka ianei kua mai uka  
mai o ke awawa, no ka mea, ua  
pa iho la kamakani mauka a lawe  
mai la i ka leo o ka ianei kua.

O kahi a ka wahine e noho nei  
nana e kuku nei, na iuka o Kea-  
napueo. I ka lohe pono ana o  
ka wahine huli kua, ua pii aku  
la na ma kahawai, a hiki i kahi  
ana i lohe ai a loa pono iho la  
iaia kana mea i huli mai ai. He  
lua la ho'i no Kahuku ma Wai-  
alua me kana ukana no ana i huli  
mai ai me ka hoomanawani,  
oia hoi kana kua kuku-kapa, oia  
kahi moolelo iki noua.
